"For the word of the cross is folly to those who are perishing, but to us who are being saved it the power of God." 1 Corinthians 1:18

One of my favorite quotes from the theologian, Martin Luther, declares this truth: "Our Lord has written the promise of the resurrection not in books alone, but in every leaf in springtime." The season of Spring is such a burst of life, color, creativity and all the wonder of Spring that is God's gift to us during Easter celebrations. 
May God inspire and raise up "new laborers" to partake in His plans and purposes for Atonement Church in 2024.

Trustees News There is always something to report about maintaining and improving Atonement's beautiful property. Thanks to the gifts from all the wonderful congregants (past and present), your Trustees have been very busy this year! In 2022, extensive weather proofing of the exterior of the education building was completed. This paved the way for the current restoration on the first floor of fourteen interior window areas. This included the removal of loose stucco, installation of new materials, extensive patching, and color-matched painting.

The Storage Room behind the Sanctuary (formerly Carol Choir room) has received a long overdue upgrade. Dilapidated cabinets have been removed, holes have been patched, and fresh paint applied. Still more to come in the future about this space!

Throughout the building we are replacing fluorescent and incandescent lighting with energy efficient LED bulbs. The new tubes and bulbs are brighter, they eliminate the need for ballasts, and they have a tremendous life cycle. As of the end of February over 125 bulbs have been replaced!
