(Excerpts from The Good News Magazine, March/April 2024: article titled, Holy Love and the Genius of Wesleyanism by Ryan Danker)

In some of John Wesley's earlier writings, John described biblical religion as "No other than love: the love of God and of all mankind; the loving God with all our heart, and soul, and strength, as (God) having first loved us, as the fountain of all good we have received...and the loving (of) every soul which God has made...as our own soul." In the spirit of the Great Commandment found in Matthew 22:36-40, Wesley continued, "This love is the great medicine of life, the never-failing remedy for all the evils of a disordered world, for all the miseries and vices of men. Wherever this (love) is, there are virtue and happiness, going hand in hand."

The article continued, "A true Wesleyan view of Scripture begins with the question of holiness, and throughout our history we have been convinced that a holy life and a biblical life are one and the same; the Bible is a means of grace, a faithful helper in that journey toward holy life, which is a Christ-like life." "And... Jesus is the pattern for holiness." Wesley's love for Jesus, for humanity, for God's Word, and the Church unite believers down through the ages in our purpose: "... to be holy as I AM is holy." (1 Peters 1:16).

This month of May we enter into the church season of Pentecost, beginning with Pentecost Sunday on May 19th. Our messages will be focusing on God's amazing sanctifying grace and the continuing process of transformation into Christ-likeness. Jesus has made us holy by His work on the cross, so we are God's holy ones- saints. FIVE INCREDIBLE THINGS HAPPEN WHEN YOU SERVE YOUR CHURCH

- 1. **You Make your church stronger.** It's like exercising your spiritual gifts. It builds up **The Body of Christ**.
- 2. <u>The Church becomes united.</u> When Jesus prayed for the future church (John 17), above all He prayed that the church would be united. When we serve together we be come invested in our church. Serving strengthens **The Body of Christ**.
- 3. You discover more about Jesus. You can read a book on how to drive, but you can't get behind the wheel and drive without the hands on practice. It's the same thing with your relationship with Jesus. You can figure out only so much in a Sunday School class room. To experience more, you're going to have to roll up your sleeves and start serving.
- 4. You mature in your faith. We look at maturity as when a person goes out and gets a job, pays bills, supports a family, etc. When you serve in your church it's a sign of Christian maturity because it shows that you've grown enough in your faith to realize that it's not just about consuming, but about giving back.
- 5. We achieve together something far greater than what we can attain on our own. When we serve Christ's church like this, we create The Body of Christ.

On a personal note, I came to church one day during the week to see a person I didn't know working with the flowers on the altar. I introduced myself and she did likewise. I told her what I was doing at the church and she explained what she does with the flowers. We talked about the cloths that were put on the altar and liecturns and pulpit. Then someone else cleaned the sanctuary. Others cleaned bathrooms, others taught Sunday School. The list goes on and on.

I had a sudden revelation that **WOW**, all these people in the church were **The Body of Christ** in action. Our people are Jesus (with skin on)..."making a well oiled mechanism" to serve the Claymont Community and beyond. **AND...I got to meet a sister in Christ that I had not known.**
